## CODE OF CONDUCT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

### SKATERS AND SPECTATORS UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- ▶ Maintain reasonable control of his or her speed and course at all times.
- ▶ Read and abide by all posted signs and warnings. Cooperate with Ice Trail staff.
- ▶ Maintain a proper lookout to avoid other skaters, objects or conditions on the ice surface.
- ▶ Accept responsibility for knowing the range of his or her ability while on skates and skate within those limits.
- ▶ Refrain from skating while under the influence of drugs, alcohol or other controlled substances.
- ▶ Leave the ice surface during ice surfacing maintenance.
- ▶ Refrain from taking food or drink onto the ice surface or the surrounding dasher boards or cap-rail.
- ▶ Refrain from acting in a manner that may cause or contribute to the injury of themselves or any other persons.
- ▶ Refrain from picking up or carrying children on the ice.
- ▶ Refrain from throwing or leaving objects on the ice surface.
- ▶ Refrain from instigating or becoming involved in any type of altercation with any other skater or spectator and shall not engage in abusive, abrasive or disorderly conduct.
- ▶ Assumption of Risk: By engaging in skating, skaters and spectators are deemed to have knowledge of, and assume the inherent risks of skating which include, but are not limited to the following:
  - Injuries that result from collisions or contact with other skaters or individuals who are on the skating surface.
  - Injuries that result from falls.
  - Injuries that involve objects or artificial structures that are within intended path of travel of the skater.
