

# Master Plan

## Approved Master Plan

A series of landforms and passive lawn areas create a clearly defined edge between sports fields in the upland areas and nature based recreation areas along the bluff and in the Creek Valley.

The Adventure Play and Splash Play River Area is oriented on the side of a 'bluff edge' landform that mimics the bluffs that are characteristic around Parker. The change in elevation between play elements adds a unique layer of interest for play.

A centralized Flexible/Open lawn area is along the south side of the main park entry drive. A stage overlooks the lawn area for large community events and gatherings.

An Adventure Trail area in the Cherry Creek Basin could include:

- BMX/Mountain Bike skills course
- Rustic picnicking in a series of naturalistic outdoor rooms
- Soft-surface trail loops

Uses adjacent to the existing Salisbury Sports Complex include expanded softball/baseball four-plex, connected to the existing complex, and two full size multi-use fields. These uses are clustered at the south end of the new park to concentrate active uses close to the existing fields.


A linear spine road with boulevard parking provides parking adjacent to most program elements.

Swales with native planting cross the site to separate different uses and convey storm water.
